However, before beginning I advise you of your rights.

1. You have the right to remain silent.
2. Anything you say can be used against you in a court of law.
3. You have the right to talk to a lawyer and have him present with you while you are being questioned.
4. If you cannot afford to hire a lawyer, one will be appointed to represent you before any questioning, if you wish one.
5. You have the right to stop answering questions or giving a statement anytime you wish and do not have to give a reason. You also have the right to demand a lawyer during the giving of a statement or the answering of questions and may stop until he arrives. If you cannot afford a lawyer, one will be appointed to represent you.

WAIVER

"I have been advised and I have read the statement of my rights shown above. I understand what my rights are, I am willing to answer questions and make a statement. I do not want a lawyer at this time but understand that I may have one at any time I so desire. I also understand that I may stop answering questions at any time. I understand and know what I am doing. No promises or threats have been made to me and no pressure of any kind has been used against me."

Q. David why did you use a different name, other than your true, name.
A. Because I have five years probation facing me In Boston, for armed robbery. ←

Q. David are you currently under the Influence of alcohol, or any narcotic substance.
A. No, I am not.

Q. David Thomas Doyle would you be willing to answer any questions, regarding an Incident that took place In Saugas Massachusetts, Involving an Individual female named Marie Iannuzzi.
A. Yes I will.

Q. Would you like an attorney present, before you answer any questions, regarding this matter.
A. No, I don't need one right now, but I could like one for the charges In Newark.

Q. When Is the last time that you saw Marie alive.
A. At a wedding reception In Winfield ass., at a place called the ship.
Did you go to the reception with Marie.
Yes I did.

Q. Did you leave with Marie.
A. No.

Q. Do you know who Marie left with.
A. She left with my cousins, Freddie Milano, they went to Freddie's house In Saugas Mass.

Q. Did you also go to Freddie's house.
A. No, I did not.

Q. Why didn't you go.
A. Because I had ripped my pants. *is my not go back*

Q. Do you know who took Marie home from your cousins house.
A. She got a ride home with a girl, who dropped her off at a bar called the Cardinals nest In East Boston.

Q. Do you know the girls name who dropped her off at this bar.
A. No, I don't.

Q. Did you ever see Marie again after the reception.
A. No I did not.

Q. Do you know anything at all about her death.
A. No, only what the police have told me, and what the Massachusetts police have told me, I identified the body at the morgue.

Q. Has everything that you have told me been the truth, and would you be willing to take a polygraph examination, In reference to what you have told me.
A. Yes, and I will take a polygraph test anywhere, because I did not kill her. I loved her, for two years. No further questions asked. statement read and ended at 3:55 P.M.
